Process:

1. Application review by March 8, 2021, finalist notified
2. In person interview the by the end of March 2021
3. Winners and schools notified in early mid-April 2021
4. Winners and schools awarded at the Education Celebration, early-mid April
5. Winners must give the higher education financial aid address and student ID by June to the chamber so monies can be sent.; if you notify us later we hope to have it filled for you by the fall semester; the earlier you give it to us, the better.
- 6. You must attend the Education Celebration.**

The scholarship check is made out to the institution upon verification of enrollment. Notification of the winner of the scholarship is in May and recipients are honored at the annual Education Celebration.
